## Information

Hibbing Community College is once again pleased to offer our College for Kids summer program. The program is available to children between the ages of 7 – 12. We put together a mix of fun exciting classes that we hope will surprise our returning students, and interest new ones; there is something for everyone!

**Dates & Times:** College For Kids 2018 will be held the week of July 23<sup>rd</sup> – July 27<sup>th</sup> 2018, Monday through Friday. All classes will be held at Hibbing Community College. Classes will begin at 9:00 a.m. and end at 3:00 p.m. daily. Child pick up will be from 3:00 to 3:15 p.m. in the College commons area. When checking your child in on Monday morning please indicate who has permission to pick up the kids. At pick-up time, the adults will 'check in' at the Key Club Desk before leaving with a child. For your child's safety, we will have only designated adults picking up children at the end of the day.

**Tuition:** The cost for the entire week is \$100. Payment must accompany the registration. The tuition includes all classes, lunch and snacks for the entire week, as well as required materials. Scholarships are available based on financial status and availability, call for an application. All Scholarship requests must be turned in 10 days before the start of classes.

**Registration:** Each student will attend one class during each section. They will attend the same five classes each day, in the same order, for the entire week. Make sure your child is registered in the correct group. The grade listed would be the grade the child is going into in the fall. It is essential to rank all the classes in each section in order of preference, 1 – 5 (1st choice, 2nd choice, etc.), in case your first (or second) choice is already filled. Registration will be accepted on a first come first serve basis. Registration and tuition can be dropped off at the HCC Business Office. It is important to list at least two (2) emergency numbers in case there is a need to reach a parent during College for Kids week. Please be sure to sign the release form on the backside of the registration form. If you need to pick up your child early, or they arrive late any time during the week, please check in at the Key Club

Desk located by the check in area. Registration begins June 15<sup>th</sup> and will go until July 20<sup>th</sup>. After July 20<sup>th</sup>, registration will be closed. **Classes fill quickly, register early!**

**Discipline & Refund Policies:** Parents of excessively disruptive children will be contacted. If misbehavior continues, students will be asked to leave the program. There are no refunds. You may cancel your registration any time up to one week prior to the beginning of classes and receive a 75% refund. No refunds thereafter.

## Scholarship Criteria

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We understand some families may have difficulty affording tuition; therefore, we are pleased to offer a tuition assistance opportunity for families who qualify. The following criteria are considered in order to determine who will receive the assistance:

### 1. Family size and income

This income and family size scale is used as a guide and is not the only determining factor.

Size of household Unit	Gross household Income earned (not take home pay)
2	\$20,665
3	\$27,991
4	\$35,317
5	\$42,643

These numbers are based on the Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP)

(If you have more dependents, add \$4,000 for each one.)

### 2. More than one child is attending College For Kids, 2018.

(An additional child from the same family is registered and attends College for Kids)

The registration must be accompanied by a partial payment of \$50.00 and the scholarship application. The applicant will be placed in the selected classes and their place will be held until the scholarship committee determines whether or not tuition assistance will be awarded. The committee will review all applications and determine recipients by July 19, 2018.

If the applicant is not awarded assistance, parents/guardians will then have the choice of making other arrangements for tuition payment, or withdrawing applicant out of the program. If the applicant is awarded a full scholarship, the partial payment of \$50 will be refunded. The maximum tuition assistance per child is \$100, and the minimum is \$25.
