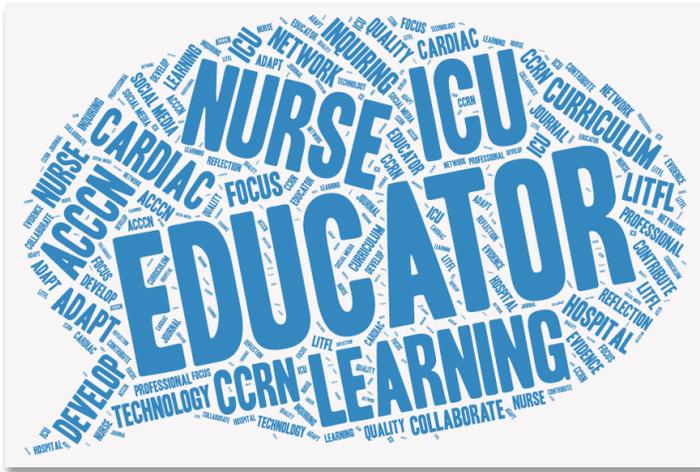

## RESOURCES FOR NURSING

### TEST PREP AND RESEARCH

It's that time of year again, the time when the nursing students all start flocking to the library to gain some peace and quiet as they frantically study for their upcoming exams, and for second-year students, the NCLEX exam hovers on the not-so-distant horizon. To help nursing students as they review their course materials and prepare for this comprehensive exam, the library now has three **new** test prep, Q&A review books available for checkout, including the most recent editions of both the Lippincott and Saunders *Comprehensive Reviews* for the NCLEX-RN Exam. The library also has a copy of Davis's *Med-Surg Success Q&A* review available for check out.

### CINAHL

Nursing students: Don't forget that the library subscribes to the CINAHL database, which is specifically designed to meet your research needs. This database contains full text of American nursing journals, and health care books covering a range of topics relevant to HCC's program studies.

### JOURNALS

The HCC Library also subscribes to two physical scientific journals: *Nursing* and *The American Journal of Nursing*.



## BLIND DATE WITH A BOOK

This Valentine's Day, stop by the library for a blind date with a book! Wrapped in brown paper, these books won't give you a chance to judge them by their covers, because you won't be able to see them. With only a few clues to let you know what type of book you're picking up, the blind date with a book gives you the opportunity to expand your horizons and read books that you might never have picked for yourself in the first place.

The HCC Library can't take credit for coming up with this idea – this type of display is gaining popularity in libraries around the country, after getting its start at a bookshop in Australia and moving to a global online marketing phenomenon at <https://blinddatewithabook.com/>, where you can select books based on nothing more than a few select descriptors.
