CATALOG DESCRIPTION:

ICD-10-CM (International Classification of Disease, 10th Revision, Clinical Modification) introduces students to diagnostic and procedural codes within the healthcare delivery systems. The students will have an understanding on how the codes influence healthcare data collected for medical research, statistics, evaluation of medical care, and reimbursement.
