- Eligibility criteria:
1. Area of Study – Students may be in any program of study.
 2. Class Standing – Students may be incoming freshman, transfer, or returning HCC students.
 3. Grade Point Average – Students must have earned a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or better.
 4. Financial Need – Students who have a financial need are given priority.

Past academic excellence and promise of future exceptional academic performance determine scholarship recipients. Applicants should complete and return this form to the HCC Financial Aid Office.

Students that are awarded must be enrolled at least half time (6+ credits) at HCC at the time of disbursement. Scholarships will apply to academic year 2018-2019 student accounts. A list of scholarships are on the back of this form. You do not need to select the one(s) you are applying for.

HCC Foundation Scholarships will not be reduced if other scholarships are received. Applications should be postmarked by April 1. Applications received after April 1 will be considered if scholarship selection has not been completed.
